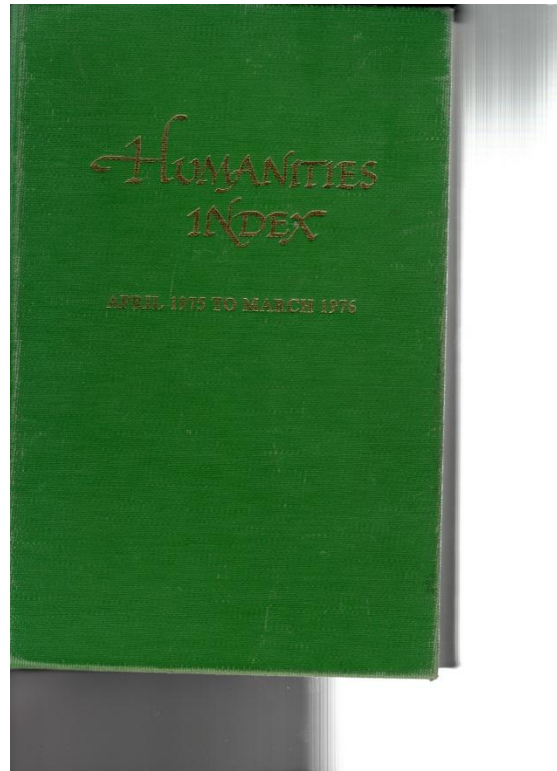


# CHOOSE YOUR PRINT INDEX

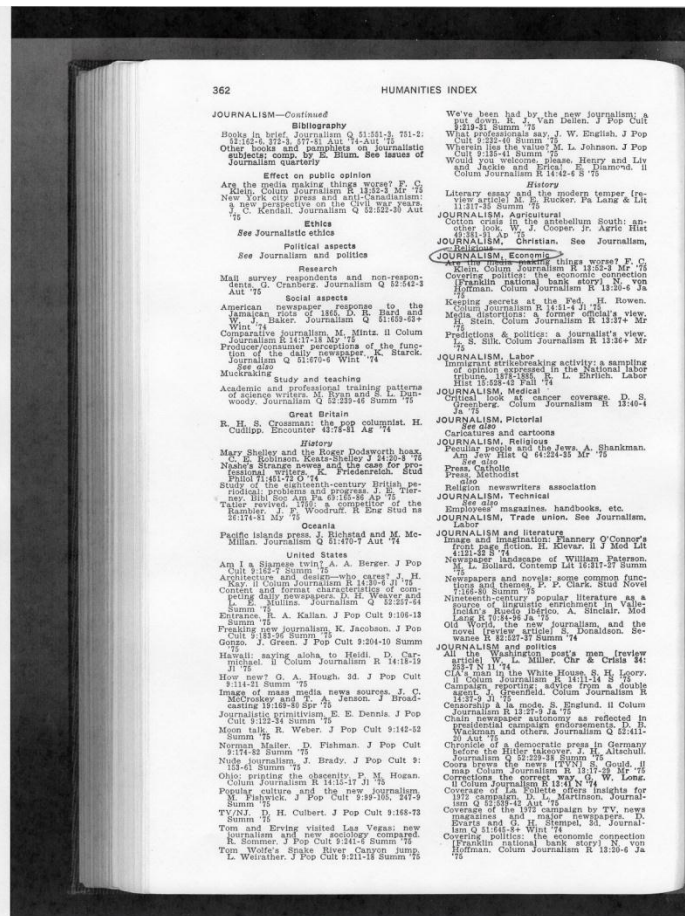
- They can be located in the online catalog or they can be found in the shelving unit directly in front of the reference desk.

- We will use the Humanities Index

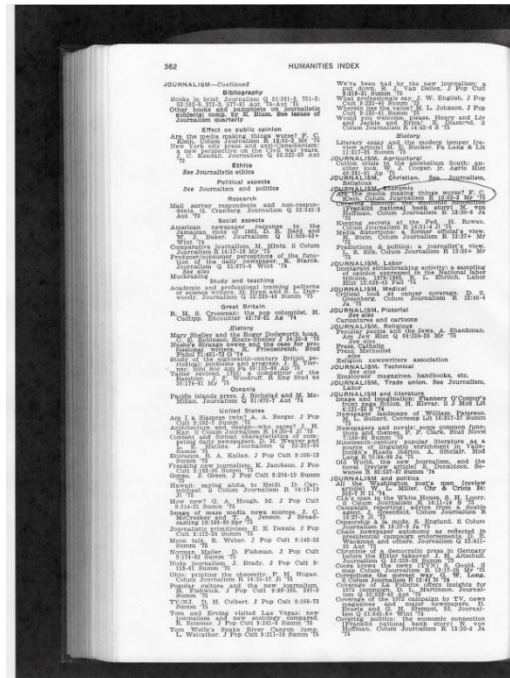


# SEARCH ALPHABETICALLY FOR JOURNALISM ECONOMICS

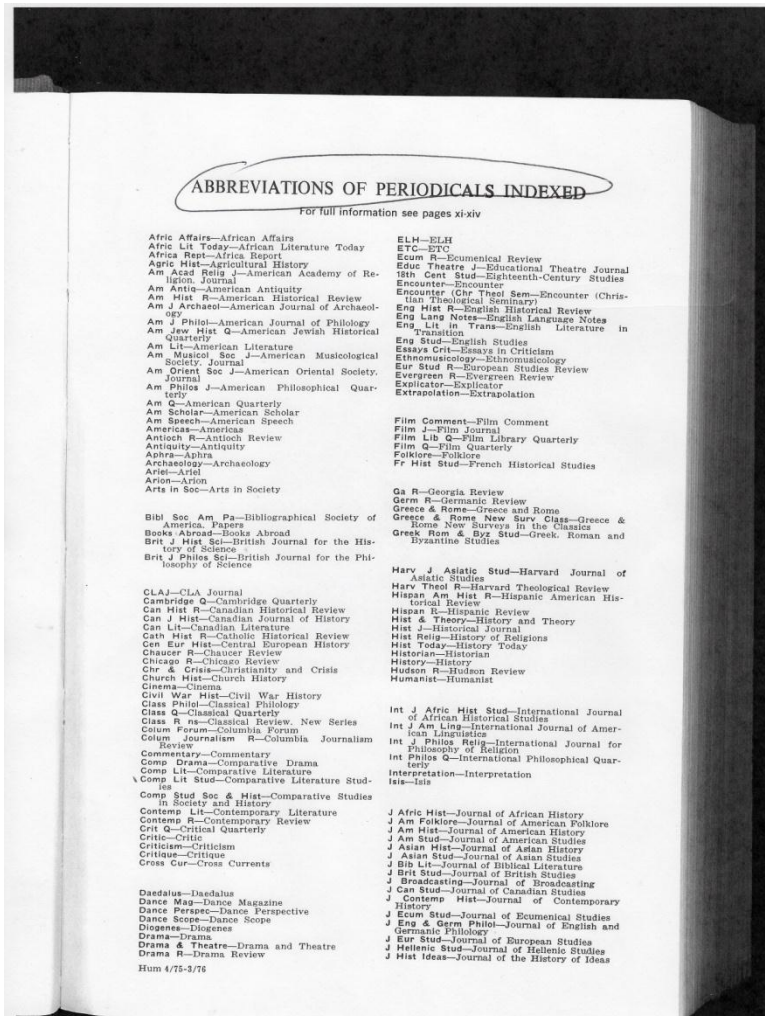

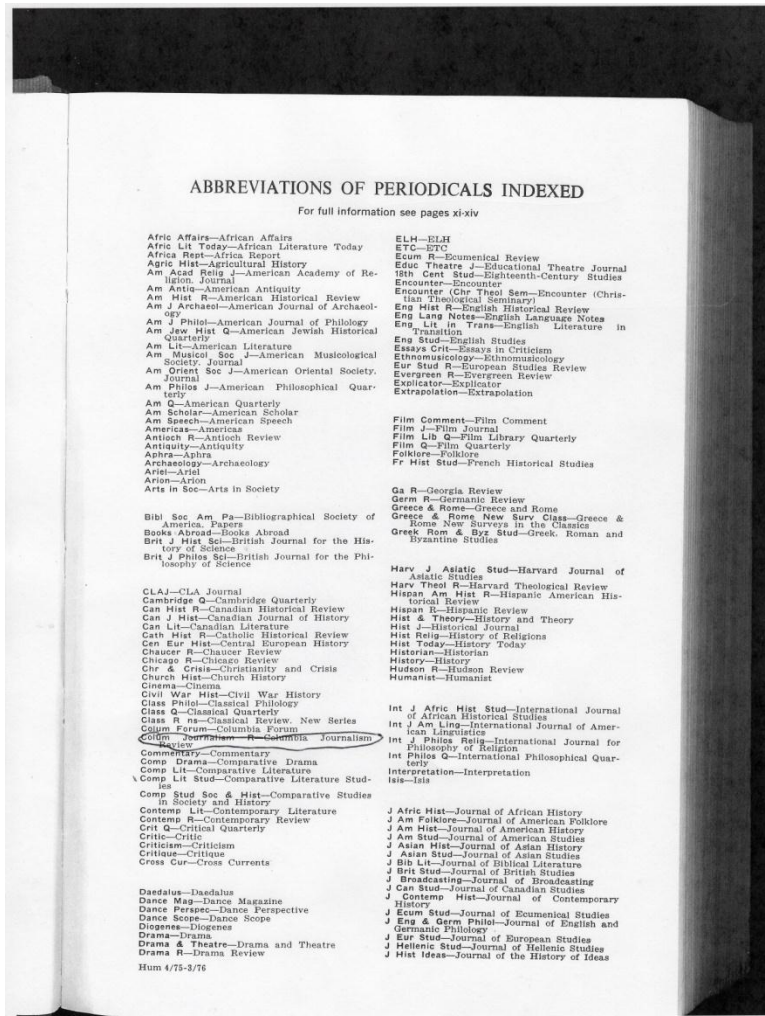

- ◉ You can check to see if we have it full text (online) by using “Full Text Journal Title Search;” which can be found on the library’s web page.
- ◉ You can also check the online catalog (WebCat).
- ◉ I found it online in “Communication & Mass Media Complete.”
- ◉ If the item is not available in full text or in print (through our online catalog); then you can request it through InterLibrary Loan (ILL).
