2. Summary of Discussion and Recommendations

a. To Risks

i. Please have the PI(s) indicate clearly exactly who will make the determination that the patient is sufficiently recovered prior to the post-op interview. Will this be the patient making this decision? Will a nurse or doctor sign off on this? Is the six week period listed in the application a random amount of time or was this provided by a medical professional.

b. Since WEBX is an online platform, please confirm that the organization managing WEBX does not ever have a digital copy of the interviews (for instance, Microsoft has a digital record of Troy Emails, Google has digital copies of all gmail emails, cell phone providers have digital records of all texts, etc). IF WEBX has this digital record on remote servers, please find out their privacy policy and include it in the application OR in an attached document. We just need to ensure that all records originating from this study are accounted for and fully disclosed.

c. To Informed Consent:

i. It is recommended that the Informed Consent be re-issued (it is not required that it be signed a second time) AFTER the surgery and BEFORE the second interview. Since the surgery itself could have significant affects on the mindset and emotions of the participant, it would add a layer of safety to reaffirm the information in the Informed Consent.

ii. There is a paragraph where it indicates that a “group” of IRB-trained researchers will have access to the data. Please clarify this section and list the specific names of those who will have access to the data.

d. While it is a good idea to provide counseling, the “free session” offered to the participant is, it appears, to be administered by a member of the research team (Eula Pines). If this is the case, the participant must be clearly notified that it is the case and this should be documented in the Informed Consent and anywhere else this free session is offered. It must also be very clear that outside referrals are available.
