 - b. Revising the survey instrument to reflect less negative bias and illuminate potential confusion by participants.
 - c. Consulting with the Troy University Athletic Director to gain insight regarding participant protection in efforts to identify and minimize unforeseen risks and perhaps benefits.
 - d. Once a clear identification of potential risks is ascertained, specifically indicate the protective measures to be taken to eliminate or minimize those risks.
 1. How will participant's identity be protected?
 2. How will the risk of potential psychological and emotional discomfort or trauma be reduced?
 3. Are the demographics currently proposed too narrow?
 4. Is the survey instrument able to produce reliable and valid results which could potentially present benefit to the athletes and/or public?
