- c. Make sure that on the scales unnecessary information is removed. For instance, the name of the family doctor, name, and address need to be removed from the scales and from the application.
- d. Add department affiliation of Dr. Hammonds on the informed consent
- e. To Methodology
 - i. Add in the Methods section that permission has been obtained for any scales being used.
 - ii. Add information about how it will be secured, who will have access, and that it will be retained for three years.
 - iii. If you recommend that certain participants visit their own physician, please add a line in the Informed Consent with it indicating that it will be at their own expense, or provide counseling information (hotline, etc.)
 - iv. Modify the gift card registration process. Provide an opportunity to opt out if they would prefer that their email address not be captured. Make sure there is something in place to ensure that personal email addresses submitted for the gift card cannot be used to link specific persons to specific survey data.
