The UGAC approved the following motions by electronic vote on December 11, 2008.

### Cell Biology

- a. Create new course: BIO 22XX Principles of Cell Biology (3) Introduction to cell structure and function with emphasis on comparative morphology, organelle structure and function, and cell physiology. *Prerequisite: BIO 1101 and L101. Corequisite: BIO L2xxx*
- b. Create new course: BIO L2XX Principles of Cell Biology Laboratory (1) Laboratory studies of cell biology with an emphasis on cell anatomy, function and specialization. *Prerequisite: BIO 1101 and L101. Corequisite: BIO 22xx*
- c. Amend the
  - i. Biology Major,
  - ii. Biology Program requirements block for
    - a) general biology concentration
    - b) ecology and field biology concentration and
    - c) medical technology concentration,
  - iii. Environmental Science Program, and
  - iv. Marine Biology Program so that
  - v. BIO 22XX Principles of Cell Biology (3) BIO L2xx Principles of Cell Biology Lab replace BIO 3372 and BIO L372.
- d. Amend the Biology Program (biomedical sciences concentration) by
  - i. Replacing BIO 4478 Cell Biology and L478 Cell Biology Lab with BIO 3372 Microbiology and L372 Microbiology Lab
- e. Amend the Biology Program (medical technology concentration) by adding BIO 3372 Microbiology and L372 Microbiology Lab to the requirements for the concentration, and by allowing students to take either the BIO 3386/L386 hematology sequence or the BIO 4471/L471 parasitology sequence.
- f. Amend the Biology Program (food safety concentration)) by adding BIO 3372 Microbiology and L372 Microbiology Lab to the list of required courses and reducing a "select 11 or more hours" block to a "Select 7 hours" block.'
- g. Amend the Biology Minor so that students may enroll in either the BIO 3372/L372 Microbiology sequence or the BIO 22XX /L2XX Principles of Cell Biology sequence.

## Music

- h. Remove the following from the course inventory:
  - i. MUS 3301
  - ii. MUS 3302
  - iii. MUS 3303
- i. Create the following new courses:
  - i. MUS 33XX Survey of Western Music History I (3) This course traces the development of Western music from the ancient and medieval worlds through the Renaissance and baroque periods.
  - ii. MUS 33XX Survey of Western Music History II (3) This course traces the development of Western music from the 18<sup>th</sup> century through the classical, romantic, and contemporary periods.
- j. Amend the Music Major and the Music Minor by substituting the two-course/6 semester hour sequence of MUS 33XX Survey of Western Music History I and MUS 33XX Survey of Western Music History II for the three-course/six semester hour sequence of MUS 3301, 3302 and 3303.
