

HOSPITALITY, SPORT AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT (HSTM) MAJOR (123 HOURS)

A major portion of the student's first and second year studies is a common curriculum called the General Studies Program. General studies courses may not be used in meeting requirements for both the General Studies Program and the requirements for a major or minor. Students must complete a six hour sequence in Literature or history.

Hospitality, Sport and Tourism Management majors must earn a grade of "C" or better in all major courses for credit toward graduation. All Hospitality, Sport and Tourism Management majors must select one 18-hour minor.

The School of Hospitality, Sport & Tourism Management believes the practical experience gained through an internship is essential to the student's education and professional growth. Therefore, all undergraduate students seeking a Bachelor of Science in HSTM are required to complete an internship.

Area I (6 hours)

A minimum grade of C is required in ENG 1101 and 1102 or their equivalents.

Any 1000-2000 level courses with an expanded historical and cultural scope in the Humanities/Fine Arts disciplines, including English, Foreign Languages, Religion, Philosophy, Classics, Theatre, Music, Dance, Communications, Sign Language, Interdisciplinary Studies, or other Humanities/Fine Arts areas (6)

Area III (11-12 hours)

A minimum grade of C is required in Mathematics. The student should consult the listing of any specialized general studies requirements for the selected major. One of the following two courses may be specified in the selected major; a higher-level Mathematics course or another Mathematics requirement may also be specified.

MTH 1110 Finite Mathematics or MTH 1112 Pre-Calculus Algebra (3)

Any 1000-2000 level laboratory sciences classes (class and lab both required) from the following Science disciplines: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Physical Science or other Science areas: (8)

Any 1000-2000 level course with a principal focus in History (3)

Any 1000-2000 level courses from the following Social Science disciplines: Anthropology, Business, Criminal Justice, Economics, Geography, History, Human Services, Leadership, Interdisciplinary Studies, Nursing, Political Science, Psychology, Religion, Social Work, Sociology, or other Social Science areas (9)
