

## HOSPITALITY, SPORT AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT (HSTM) MAJOR (123 Hours)

Hospitality, Sport and Tourism Management majors must earn a grade of “C” or better in all major courses for credit toward graduation. All Hospitality, Sport and Tourism Management majors must select one 18-hour minor.

The School of Hospitality, Sport & Tourism Management believes the practical experience gained through an internship is essential to the student’s education and professional growth. Therefore, all undergraduate students seeking a Bachelor of Science in HSTM are required to complete an internship.

Students must complete a six hour sequence in World/British/American Literature OR US History/Western Civilization/World History. A total of six hours selected from Area II and/or Area IV must be international in scope. International courses are designated with an asterisk.
