

TEP ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to college does not entitle you to TEP Admission. Several requirements must be successfully met, and steps followed, for TEP Admission to occur. The steps to TEP Admissions are as follows:

- _____ Take EDU 3310 (The Professional Educator) and complete with a grade of "C" or better
- _____ Mandatory Group Advisement Session
- _____ Completion of Impromptu Essay
- _____ Completion of a minimum of 12 hours of Observation
- _____ Receive an initial score on the APTTP (Registration for the exam cannot be used for admission. You must have an initial score.)
- _____ Successful completion of Speech and Interview, conducted with your departmental advisor
- _____ Completion of the required English and Math Courses for your major with a grade of "C" or better in each

- _____ Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75 or higher in the areas of Overall, Teaching Field and Professional Studies
- _____ Completion of a minimum of 80% of your required General Studies
- _____ Suitability letter, showing fingerprint clearance.
- _____ Passing score on State Approved Math Modules

Once all of the above requirements have been met, you must schedule a meeting with Mrs. Jennifer Couch-Hollis, Hawkins Hall Room 330, for formal TEP Admission. You may email Mrs. Hollis at jchollis@troy.edu for an appointment. You will NOT be admitted to TEP until the formal meeting is conducted. In not conducting this step, your registration, internship and graduation can be postponed, due to failure to comply with Troy University and Alabama State Standards.
