Teaching play and social skills are a part of a quality behavioral program for children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). The majority of clients with ASD are boys, and a large component of play and social interactions for many boys involves sports. To be proficient in sports and other physical activities, there are prerequisite foundation skills. Thus, it is important for behavior analysts to teach foundation locomotor (movement) and object-control (those involving manipulating objects) skills that will facilitate future participation in sports; that is, pre-sports skills. For behavior analysts who have limited experience participating in sports or in teaching pre-sports skills, collaborating with an expert from the field of kinesiology, the study of body movement, can be valuable. This paper introduces the study of body movement to behavior analysts and presents teaching targets for prerequisite

foundation skills for sports participation such as jumping, hopping, sliding, striking, catching, and running.
